Aug. 23: 7 p.m. - existing bridge is closed to traffic and traffic is switched to detour 7 p.m. to midnight - bridge demolition and removal of existing bridge

Aug. 24: midnight to 3 a.m. - set precast abutments and wing walls, place riprap 5 to 7 a.m. - set precast deck sections

7 a.m. to 9 a.m. - flow fill around substructure and epoxy grout superstructure

9 a.m. to noon - cure time

noon to 5 p.m. - bridge backfill, earthwork, and grading

5 p.m. to 7 p.m. - final roadway paving

7 p.m. - open new bridge to traffic

All times are subject to change, but the bridge will be completed by Monday morning! The best viewing opportunities will occur from Friday midnight to Saturday 3 a.m. (when precast abutments and wing walls are set) and from 5 a.m. to 7 a.m. Saturday (when the precast deck sections are set).
